Denmark

- Scandinavian country
- Population 5,4 million
- 43.000 square kilometers
- Highest point 200 m above sea level
- 5 regions
- 12 Police districts
- 98 municiplities
- Many cyclists almost every Dane owns a bicycle



2013 – a special year for Danish Road Safety

- 25 years anniversary for the first National Road Safety Action plan
- Historic low figures for killed and injured
- Winner of the European Transport Safety
 Council PIN Award (PIN = Performance Index)
- New National Road Safety Action Plan 2013-2020












Focus areas 2013-2020

- Speeding
- Alcohol and drugs
- Inattention
- Failure to wear seat-belts and helmets
- Pedestrians
- Cyclists and moped riders
- Young drivers up to age 24
- Meeting accidents
- Single-vehicle accidents
- Accidents at rural junctions
- Need for research and knowledge




Killed in traffic in Denmark 2004-2013

Killed in traffic in the Scandinavian Countries 1997-2013



Road Safety Policy Vision Zero – the Danish Approach

The Danish Road Safety Commission is working to ensure that:

- Road users' errors in traffic do not cause serious accidents
- Deliberate dangerous driving is kept to a minimum



Road Safety Management

Main intervention areas has combined

- Legislation
- Road engineering
- Enforcement
- Vehicle Safety
- Communication and Education




Close cooperation and coordination between key players

- Ministry of Transport Road and vehicle administration)
- Ministry of Justice Enforcement and public awareness and Road safety education
- Municipalities, police, NGO's etc.



Number of municipalities with a Road Safety Action Plan in 2013



Road Safety Management

- The National Road Safety Action Plan is transformed into local Road Safety Action Plans in Municipalities
- Close cooperation and coordination between responsible central bodies and municipalities
- Close cooperation between local road authorities and local police





Accident data and research

- Danish accident data is very detailed
- The Danish Accident Investigation Board produces thematic reports on different accident types – had played a significant role in media and political decisions
- Annual in-depth-studies of all fatal accidents since 2011





Measures against speeding - Road engeneering

- Speed calming measures
- Black spot intersections are pointed out and changed into roundabouts



Measures against speeding - enforcement

- "Automatic" speed control since 2000
- Demerit point system from 2005
- Moped speed new enforcement to reveal tuned mopeds
- Campaigns in cooperation with Police




Vehicle Safety - Tax reduction for safety technology

has induced fast implementation – also in small cars:

- **ABS**
- Double airbags ESC









Inattention, Road Engineering

- Rumble grooves on two lane rural roads
- Center guardrails

Registration and short description of every fatal traffic accident since 2001







Children

- 90 % reduction in killed and injured children since the 70's
- Traffic safety education mandatory in school
- Focus on child safety in cars and on bicycle
- Parents involved in training and role models in real traffic
- Traffic policies in schools

- Continuous monitoring
- Driver Education
- Work Related driving
- Facts Sheets
- Hospital data
